III. New Business

- MI/RI training will be embedded in PL on Wed. Teachers are using the data to guide instruction, and this data can help inform teacher effectiveness.
 - i. The MI/RI data can be used next year. The info is saved for returning students & teachers. As a practice, students are re-tested early to account for summer learning effects. The Milestones data will be available and is at the fingertips of teachers/leaders on SLDS (statewide longitudinal data system). MI/RI data can actually be uploaded to the system at the discretion of districts
- Percentiles in growth was included as a topic of conversation. The point difference from pre-post is not an ideal comparison because it does not account for student difference or "like" starting points as the SGPs do. Great point! Needs to be explored further. Additional reports will be included.
- The AC roles doc that was given outlines "best practices" on the roles & responsibility of the committee, so one option is to start there - Definitely a broader conversation on the entry of new members (e.g., board guidelines for committees).
